Teased mercilessly at school for being fat, she spent most of her time daydreaming on the front porch with a MoonPie in her hand, or giving mandatory concerts for the ladies held captive under the dryers. These ladies were a product of their upbringing and "stories" they were told as women in their day (1950s, 1960s).

In this candid, interactive and inspiring workshop, Faye Lane explores “stories” women have been told in various eras and regions of the country and how these stories shape women's lives.
